

MERCY

Mercy is considered to be a key element in Scripture. Most "translations" include many references to mercy. Below is a listing of words in both Hebrew and Greek from the KJV Bible and Strong's Exhaustive Concordance that are translated as "mercy", "merciful", or "mercies".

Hebrew terms are "translated" in this manner 267 times. Greek terms are "translated in this manner 66 times.

Yet a review of these terms reveals a most interesting fact:

There is no Hebrew or Greek term that is properly defined as mercy.

How is it, then, that we have so many terms "translated" as mercy (or its variations) in our Bibles?

Please review the following information carefully, and prayerfully. Ask YAHWEH to teach you His Truth. He'll reveal to you what He wants you to understand if you permit Him to do so.

The primary goal of this study, and others like it that are being prepared, is to help eliminate confusion within The Scriptures. The current state of affairs has left us with innumerable "translations" that are not really "translations" at all. Instead, they are misleading presentations of the "traditions of men".

There's a special term for this. It's called **eisegesis**. It means placing one's own ideas into a text to make it conform to one's own world view or belief system. **Exegesis**, on the other hand, is seeking to discover what the text actually says, and means.

In the following word study these conventions will be used:

[term] = proper translation

{ } = Writer's insertions for purposes of clarity.

{Best - } = The best translation of the term where the given "translation" is misleading or confusing.

(This is particularly important when multiple English words are used in the KJV as "translations" of the term.)

[not used] = the term is not translated in the KJV as the key word for this study.

HEBREW TERMS:

Connected terms: [occur 29 times]
--

2603. **חָנַן** *chanan*, *khaw-nan'*; a primitive root (compare 2583); **properly, to bend or stoop in kindness to an inferior; to favor**, bestow; causatively to implore (i.e. move to favor by petition): **[occurs 28 times]**

—beseech, x fair, (be, find, show) favor(-able), be (deal, give, grant (showing favor(-ly)), intreat, (be) merciful, have (show) mercy (on, upon), have pity upon, pray, make supplication, x very.

2604. **חָנַן** *chanan*, *khan-an'*; (Aramaic) corresponding to 2603; **to favor** or (causatively) to entreat: **[occurs 1 time]**
—show mercy, make supplication.

Note: These terms should always be translated as "favor". They should never be translated as "mercy, merciful, or mercies".

Connected terms: **[occur 157 times]**

2617. **חֶסֶד** *cheçed*, *kheh'-sed*; from 2616; **kindness**; by implication (towards Elohim) piety: rarely (by opposition) reproof, or (subject.) beauty:

[occurs 154 times]

—favor, good deed(-liness, -ness), kindly, (loving-)kindness, merciful (kindness), mercy, pity, reproach, wicked thing.

2616. **חָסַד** *chaçad*, *khaw-sad'*; a primitive root; **properly, perhaps to bow (the neck only (compare 2603) in courtesy to an equal)**, i.e. **to be kind**; also (by euphem. (compare 1288), but rarely) to reprove:
—show self merciful, put to shame.

2623. **חָסִיד** *chaçiyd*, *khaw-seed'*; from 2616; **properly, kind**, i.e. (religiously) pious (a saint): **[occurs 3 times]**

—godly (man), good, holy (one), merciful, saint, (un-)godly.

Note: Each of these terms should be translated as "kindness", and never as mercy. Also, "kindness" is a form of showing favor.

3819. **לֹא רַחֲמָה** *Lo^s Ruchamah*, *lo roo-khaw-maw'*; from 3808 and 7355; **not pitied** {**Best: not shown compassion**}; Lo-Ruchamah, the symbol. name of a son of Hosea:

[occurs 1 time]

—Lo-ruhamah.

Note: This is a special usage.

Connected Terms: **[occur 81 times]**

These are all from the same root word.
Several are different only because of the use of different vowel pointings, which are not in the original text.

7349. **רַחֻמִּים** *rachuwm*, *rakh-oom'*; from 7355; **compassionate**:

[occurs 8 times]

—full of compassion, merciful

7355. רַחַם **racham**, *raw-kham*´; a primitive root; **to fondle; by implication, to love, especially to compassionate**: **[occurs 42 times]**—have compassion (on, upon), love, (find, have, obtain, show) mercy(-iful, on, upon), (have) pity, Ruhamah, x surely.

7356. רַחַם **racham**, *rakh´-am*; from 7355; **compassion (in the plural)**; by extension, the womb (as cherishing the fetus); by implication, a maiden: **[occurs 30 times]**
—bowels, compassion, damsel, tender love, (great, tender) mercy, pity, womb.

7358. רֶחֶם **rechem**, *rekh´-em*; from 7355; **the womb** (compare 7356): **[Not used]**
—matrix, womb.

7359. רַחֵם **rchem**, *rekh-ame*´; (Aramaic) corresponding to 7356; (plural) **pity {Best: compassion}** **[occurs 1 time]**
—mercy.

7360. רַחַם **racham**, *raw-khawm*´; or (feminine) רַחֲמָה **rachamah**, *raw-khaw-maw*´; from 7355; a kind of vulture (supposed to be tender towards its young): **[Not used]**
—gier- eagle.

7362. רַחֲמָנִי **rachmaniy**, *rakh-maw-nee*´; from 7355; **compassionate**: **[Not used]**
—pitiful.

Note: Each of these terms should be properly translated as "compassion", not "mercy". See the English definition of mercy below.

GREEK TERMS:

448. ἀνίλεως **anileos**, *an-ee´-leh-occe*; from 1 (as a negative particle) and 2436; **inexorable**: **[occurs 1 time]**
— without mercy.

Note: Inexorable means: cannot be moved or influenced by persuasion or entreaty; unrelenting; inflexible.

There is nothing in that definition that mentions mercy.

2436. ἵλεως **hileos**, *hil´-eh-occe*; perhaps from the alternate form of 138; **cheerful (as attractive), i.e. propitious**; adverbially **(by Hebraism) Elohim be showing favor!**, i.e. (in averting some calamity) far be it:
— be it far, merciful.

Note: To be showing favor (the Hebraism identified) means **to show favor**. It does not mean "have mercy". **{Best - as Hebraism: Elohim show favor.}**

Connected Terms: **[occur 57 times]**

These are all related terms with the same basic meaning.

1652. ἔλεεινός *eleeinos*, *el-eh-i-nos'*; from 1656; **pitiable**: {**Best: deserving compassion**}

[Not used]

— miserable.

1653. ἐλεέω *eleeo*, *el-eh-eh'-o*; from 1656; **to compassionate** (by word or deed, specially, by divine grace):

[occurs 27 times]

— have compassion (pity on), have (obtain, receive, show) mercy (on).

1654. ἐλεημοσύνη *eleemosune*, *el-eh-ay-mos-oo'-nay*; from 1656;

compassionateness, i.e. (as exercised towards the poor) beneficence, or (concretely) a benefaction:

[Not used]

— alms(-deeds).

1655. ἐλεήμων *eleemon*, *el-eh-ay'-mone*; from 1653; **compassionate** (actively):

[occurs 2 times]

— merciful.

1656. ἔλεος *eleos*, *el'-eh-os*; of uncertain affinity; **compassion** (human or divine, especially active):

[occurs 28 times]

— (+ tender) mercy.

Connected terms: **[occur 8 times]**

3628. οἰκτιρμός *oiktirmos*, *oyk-tir-mos'*; from 3627; **pity**: {**Best: have compassion**}

[occurs 5 times]

— mercy.

3627. οἰκτεῖρω *oikteiro*, *oyk-ti'-ro* also (in certain tenses) prolonged;
οἰκτερέω *oiktereo*, *oyk-ter-eh'-o*; from οἰκτος *oiktos* (pity); **to exercise pity**: — **have compassion on**.

3629. οἰκτίρων *oiktirmon*, *oyk-tir'-mone*; from 3627; **compassionate**:

[occurs 3 times]

— merciful, of tender mercy.

NOTE: All of the above Greek terms except 448 have to do with compassion, not "mercy". See the English definition of mercy below.

3741. ὅσιος *hosios*, *hos'-ee-os*; of uncertain affinity; **properly, right** (by intrinsic or divine character; thus distinguished from 1342, which refers rather to human statutes and relations; from 2413, which denotes formal consecration; and from 40, which relates to purity from defilement), i.e. **hallowed** (pious, sacred, sure):

[occurs 1 time]

— holy, mercy, shall be.

Note: This seems to be an odd usage and can be disregarded for the purposes of this study.

No Key number =

[occurs 32 times]

- this means there is no Hebrew or Greek word upon which the "translated" term is based.
- It is supplied by the translator at his or her discretion.

ENGLISH DEFINITIONS:

MERCY:

1. **a refraining from harming or punishing offenders, enemies, persons in one's power, etc.;** kindness in excess of what may be expected or demanded by fairness; forbearance and compassion
2. **a disposition to forgive**, pity, or be kind
3. **the power to forgive or be kind**; clemency; as, throw yourself on his mercy
4. kind or **compassionate** treatment; relief of suffering
5. a fortunate thing; thing to be grateful for; blessing

KIND:

- In other words, pity is equivalent to compassion.

CONCLUSIONS:

There are three primary Hebrew terms "translated" as mercy or its variations.

There are two primary Greek terms "translated" as mercy or its variations.

However, there is no Hebrew or Greek term that is properly translated as mercy or its variations.

Having reviewed the above definitions

of the Hebrew terms, Strong's Numbers 2617 and 2623

both should properly be translated as **kindness** (with its variations).

The Greek terms should all be properly translated as **compassion**.

None of these terms should be properly translated as mercy (with its variations).

If the Hebrew and Greek terms were properly translated

we would note that they fit perfectly

into one of the key themes of Scripture:

Love YAHWEH above ALL things, and with every particle of your being.

And, love your neighbor as you love yourself.

If you are doing these two things

you are being "kind" and "compassionate".

They are really two forms of the same concept.

They are also declared to be part

of the very character, of YAHWEH.

Each is tied directly to the Hebrew and Greek terms related to the concept of **to favor, or to show favor**.

While these terms are often "translated" as **grace**

there is no term in either Hebrew or Greek

that carries that denotation.

As is so often the case,

a multiplicity of English terms

with the same or similar meanings,

and sometimes even directly opposite meanings,

simply leads to confusion

about the fundamental concepts involved.

We can, and should, do better.

In a search to understand Scripture
as clearly as possible
one thing becomes evident.
Inconsistent and improper "translation" of terms
results in confusion.

HEBREW KEY NUMBERS:

For these two terms see the study on "grace"

2603 - to favor [occurs 77 times]

2604 - to favor [occurs 2 times]

2616 - to be kind [occurs 3 times]

2Sam. 22:26 With the **kind (2623)** You will show yourself **kind (2616)**, and with the upright man You will show Yourself upright.

Psa. 18:25 With the **kind (2623)** You will show Yourself **kind (2616)**; with an upright man You will show Yourself upright;

Prov. 25:10 Lest he that hears *it* puts you to **reproach**, and your slander returns.

2616. Special Form: רָחַם yechessed - Verb piel imperfect third masculine singular - **to reproach** {Note: In Hebrew a "yud" used as a prefix reverses the sense of the word. What was kindness becomes reproach. Technically, this could be classed as a different word, based on the same root.}

2617 - kindness [occurs 247 times]
{154 times translated as mercy}

Gen. 19:19 Behold now, your servant has found grace in your sight, and you have magnified your **kindness**, which you have showed unto me in saving my life; and I cannot escape to the mountain, lest some evil take me, and I die:

Gen. 20:13 And it came to pass, when Elohim caused me to wander from my father's house, that I said unto her, This *is* your **kindness** which you shall show unto me; at every place where we shall come, say of me, He *is* my brother.

Gen. 21:23 Now therefore swear unto me here by Elohim that you will not deal falsely with me, nor with my son, nor with my son's son: *but* according to the **kindness** that I have done unto you, you shall do unto me, and to the land wherein you have sojourned.

Gen. 24:12 And he said, O YAHWEH Elohim of my master Abraham, I pray you, send me good speed this day, and show **kindness** unto my master Abraham.

Gen. 24:14 And let it come to pass, that the damsel to whom I shall say, Let down your pitcher, I pray you, that I may drink; and she shall say, Drink, and I will give your camels drink also: *let the same be she that* you have appointed for your servant Isaac; and thereby shall I know that you have showed **kindness** unto my master.

Gen. 24:27 And he said, Blessed *be* YAHWEH Elohim of my master Abraham, who has not left destitute my master of his **kindness** and his truth: I *being* in the way, YAHWEH led me to the house of my master's brethren.

Gen. 24:49 And now if ye will deal **kindly** and truly with my master, tell me: and if not, tell me; that I may turn to the right hand, or to the left.

Gen. 32:10 I am not worthy of the least of all the **kindnesses**, and of all the truth, which you have showed unto your servant; for with my staff I passed over this Jordan; and now I am become two bands.

Gen. 39:21 But YAHWEH was with Joseph, and showed him **kindness**, and gave him favor in the sight of the keeper of the prison.

Gen. 40:14 But think on me when it shall be well with you, and show **kindness**, I pray you, unto me, and make mention of me unto Pharaoh, and bring me out of this house:

Gen. 47:29 And the time drew near that Israel must die: and he called his son Joseph, and said unto him, If now I have found favor in your sight, put, I pray you, your hand under my thigh, and deal **kindly** and truly with me; bury me not, I pray you, in Egypt:

Ex. 15:13 You in your **kindness** have led forth the people *which* you have redeemed: you have guided *them* in your strength unto your holy habitation.

Ex. 20:6 And showing **kindness** unto yousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

Ex. 34:6 And YAHWEH passed by before him, and proclaimed, YAHWEH, YAHWEH Elohim, merciful and showing favor, longsuffering, and abundant in **kindness** and truth,
Ex. 34:7 Keeping **kindness** for yousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear *the guilty*; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth *generation*.

Lev. 20:17 And if a man shall take his sister, his father's daughter, or his mother's daughter, and see her nakedness, and she see his nakedness; it *is* a wicked **thing**; and they shall be cut off in the sight of their people: he has uncovered his sister's nakedness; he shall bear his iniquity.

Num. 14:18 YAHWEH *is* longsuffering, and of great **kindness**, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing *the guilty*, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth *generation*.

Num. 14:19 Pardon, I beseech you, the iniquity of this people according unto the greatness of your **kindness**, and as you have forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now.

Deut. 5:10 And showing **kindness** unto yousands of them that love me and keep my commandments.

Deut. 7:9 Know therefore that YAHWEH your Elohim, he *is* Elohim, the faithful Elohim, which keepeth covenant and **kindness** with them that love him and keep his commandments to a yousand generations;

Deut. 7:12 Wherefore it shall come to pass, if ye hearken to these judgments, and keep, and do them, that YAHWEH your Elohim shall keep unto you the covenant and the **kindness** which he swore to your fathers:

Josh. 2:12 Now therefore, I pray you, swear unto me by YAHWEH, since I have showed you **kindness**, that ye will also show **kindness** unto my father's house, and give me a true token:

Josh. 2:14 And the men answered her, Our life for yours, if ye utter not this our business. And it shall be, when YAHWEH has given us the land, that we will deal **kindly** and truly with you.

Judg. 1:24 And the spies saw a man come forth out of the city, and they said unto him, Show us, we pray you, the entrance into the city, and we will show you **kindness**.

Judg. 8:35 Neither showed they **kindness** to the house of Jerubbaal, *namely*, Gideon, according to all the goodness which he had showed unto Israel.

Ruth 1:8 And Naomi said unto her two daughters in law, Go, return each to her mother's house: YAHWEH deal **kindly** with you, as you have dealt with the dead, and with me.

Ruth 2:20 And Naomi said unto her daughter in law, Blessed *be* he of YAHWEH, who has not left off his **kindness** to the living and to the dead. And Naomi said unto her, The man *is* near of kin unto us, one of our next kinsmen.

Ruth 3:10 And he said, Blessed *be* you of YAHWEH, my daughter: *for* you have showed more **kindness** in the latter end than at the beginning, inasmuch as you followedst not young men, whether poor or rich.

1Sam. 15:6 And Saul said unto the Kenites, Go, depart, get you down from among the Amalekites, lest I destroy you with them: for you showed **kindness** to all the children of Israel, when they came up out of Egypt. So the Kenites departed from among the Amalekites.

1Sam. 20:8 Therefore you shall deal **kindly** with your servant; for you have brought your servant into a covenant of YAHWEH with you: notwithstanding, if there be in me iniquity, slay me yourself; for why shouldst you bring me to your father?

1Sam. 20:14 And you shall not only while yet I live show me the **kindness** of YAHWEH, that I die not:

1Sam. 20:15 But *a/so* you shall not cut off your **kindness** from my house for ever: no, not when YAHWEH has cut off the enemies of David every one from the face of the earth.

2Sam. 2:5 And David sent messengers unto the men of Jabeshgilead, and said unto them, Blessed *be* ye of YAHWEH, that ye have showed this **kindness** unto your YAHWEH, *even* unto Saul, and have buried him.

2Sam. 2:6 And now YAHWEH show **kindness** and truth unto you: and I also will requite you this kindness, because ye have done this thing.

2Sam. 3:8 Then was Abner very wroth for the words of Ishbosheth, and said, *Am I a dog's head, which against Judah do show **kindness** this day unto the house of Saul your father, to his brethren, and to his friends, and have not delivered you into the hand of David, that you chargest me to day with a fault concerning this woman?*

2Sam. 7:15 But my **kindness** shall not depart away from him, as I took *it* from Saul, whom I put away before you.

2Sam. 9:1 And David said, Is there yet any that is left of the house of Saul, that I may show him **kindness** for Jonathan's sake?

2Sam. 9:3 And the king said, *Is there not yet any of the house of Saul, that I may show the **kindness** of Elohim unto him? And Ziba said unto the king, Jonathan has yet a son, which is lame on his feet.*

2Sam. 9:7 And David said unto him, Fear not: for I will surely show you **kindness** for Jonathan your father's sake, and will restore you all the land of Saul your father; and you shall eat bread at my table continually.

2Sam. 10:2 Then said David, I will show **kindness** unto Hanun the son of Nahash, as his father showed **kindness** unto me. And David sent to comfort him by the hand of his servants for his father. And David's servants came into the land of the children of Ammon.

2Sam. 15:20 Whereas you camest *but* yesterday, should I this day make you go up and down with us? seeing I go where I may, return you, and take back your brethren: **kindness** and truth *be* with you.

2Sam. 16:17 And Absalom said to Hushai, *Is this your **kindness** to your friend? why wentest you not with your friend?*

2Sam. 22:51 *He is* the tower of salvation for his king: and showeth **kindness** to his anointed, unto David, and to his seed for evermore.

1Kings 2:7 But show **kindness** unto the sons of Barzillai the Gileadite, and let them be of those that eat at your table: for so they came to me when I fled because of Absalom your brother.

1Kings 3:6 And Solomon said, You have showed unto your servant David my father great **kindness**, according as he walked before you in truth, and in righteousness, and in uprightness of heart with you; and you have kept for him this great **kindness**, that you have given him a son to sit on his throne, as *it is* this day.

1Kings 8:23 And he said, YAHWEH Elohim of Israel, *there is* no Elohim like you, in heaven above, or on earth beneath, who keepest covenant and **kindness** with your servants that walk before you with all their heart:

1Kings 20:31 And his servants said unto him, Behold now, we have heard that the kings of the house of Israel *are* **kind** kings: let us, I pray you, put sackcloth on our loins, and ropes upon our heads, and go out to the king of Israel: peradventure he will save your life.

1Chr. 16:34 O give thanks unto YAHWEH; for *he is* good; for his **kindness endureth** for ever.

1Chr. 16:41 And with them Heman and Jeduthun, and the rest that were chosen, who were expressed by name, to give thanks to YAHWEH, because his **kindness endures** for ever;

1Chr. 17:13 I will be his father, and he shall be my son: and I will not take my **kindness** away from him, as I took *it* from *him* that was before you:

1Chr. 19:2 And David said, I will show **kindness** unto Hanun the son of Nahash, because his father showed **kindness** to me. And David sent messengers to comfort him concerning his father. So the servants of David came into the land of the children of Ammon to Hanun, to comfort him.

2Chr. 1:8 And Solomon said unto Elohim, You have showed great **kindness** to David my father, and have made me to reign in his stead.

2Chr. 5:13 It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers *were* as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking YAHWEH; and when they lifted up *their* voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of musick, and praised YAHWEH, *saying*, For *he is* good; for his **kindness endures** for ever: that *then* the house was filled with a cloud, *even* the house of YAHWEH;

2Chr. 6:14 And said, O YAHWEH Elohim of Israel, *there is* no Elohim like you in the heaven, nor in the earth; which keeps covenant, and *shows* **kindness** to your servants, that walk before you with all their hearts:

2Chr. 6:42 O YAHWEH Elohim, turn not away the face of thine anointed: remember the **kindnesses** of David your servant.

2Chr. 7:3 And when all the children of Israel saw how the fire came down, and the glory of YAHWEH upon the house, they bowed themselves with their faces to the ground upon the pavement, and worshipped, and praised YAHWEH, *saying*, For *he is* good; for his **kindness endurev** for ever.

2Chr. 7:6 And the priests waited on their offices: the Levites also with instruments of musick of YAHWEH, which David the king had made to praise YAHWEH, because his **kindness endures** for ever, when David praised by their ministry; and the priests sounded trumpets before them, and all Israel stood.

2Chr. 20:21 And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto YAHWEH, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise YAHWEH; for his **kindness endures** for ever.

2Chr. 24:22 Thus Joash the king remembered not the **kindness** which Jehoiada his father had done to him, but slew his son. And when he died, he said, YAHWEH look upon *it*, and require *it*.

2Chr. 32:32 Now the rest of the acts of Hezekiah, and his **kindness**, behold, they *are* written in the vision of Isaiah the prophet, the son of Amoz, *and* in the book of the kings of Judah and Israel.

2Chr. 35:26 Now the rest of the acts of Josiah, and his **kindness**, according to *that which* was written in the law of YAHWEH,

Ezra 3:11 And they sang together by course in praising and giving thanks unto YAHWEH; because *he is* good, for his **kindness endures** for ever toward Israel. And all the people shouted with a great shout, when they praised YAHWEH, because the foundation of the house of YAHWEH was laid.

Ezra 7:28 And has extended **kindness** unto me before the king, and his counsellors, and before all the king's mighty princes. And I was strengthened as the hand of YAHWEH my Elohim *was* upon me, and I gathered together out of Israel chief men to go up with me.

Ezra 9:9 For we *were* bondmen; yet our Elohim has not forsaken us in our bondage, but has extended **kindness** unto us in the sight of the kings of Persia, to give us a reviving, to set up the house of our Elohim, and to repair the desolations thereof, and to give us a wall in Judah and in Jerusalem.

Neh. 1:5 And said, I beseech you, O YAHWEH Elohim of heaven, the great and terrible Elohim, that keepeth covenant and **kindness** for them that love him and observe his commandments:

Neh. 9:17 And refused to obey, neither were mindful of your wonders that you didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but you *art* a Elohim ready to pardon, showing favor and merciful, slow to anger, and of great **kindness**, and forsookest them not.

Neh. 9:32 Now therefore, our Elohim, the great, the mighty, and the terrible Elohim, who keepest covenant and **kindness**, let not all the trouble seem little before you, that has come upon us, on our kings, on our princes, and on our priests, and on our prophets, and on our fathers, and on all your people, since the time of the kings of Assyria unto this day.

Neh. 13:14 Remember me, O my Elohim, concerning this, and wipe not out my **kindnesses** that I have done for the house of my Elohim, and for the offices thereof.

Neh. 13:22 And I commanded the Levites that they should cleanse themselves, and *that* they should come *and* keep the gates, to sanctify the sabbath day. Remember me, O my Elohim, *concerning* this also, and spare me according to the greatness of your **kindness**.

Esth. 2:9 And the maiden pleased him, and she obtained **kindness** of him; and he speedily gave her her things for purification, with such things as belonged to her, and seven maidens, *which were* meet to be given her, out of the king's house: and he preferred her and her maids unto the best *place* of the house of the women.

Esth. 2:17 And the king loved Esther above all the women, and she obtained favor and **kindness** in his sight more than all the virgins; so that he set the royal crown upon her head, and made her queen instead of Vashti.

Job 6:14 To him that is afflicted **kindness** *should be showed* from his friend; but he forsaketh the fear of the Almighty.

Job 10:12 You have granted me life and **kindness**, and your visitation has preserved my spirit.

Job 37:13 He causeth it to come, whether for correction, or for his land, or for **kindness**.

Psa. 5:7 But as for me, I will come *into* your house in the multitude of your **kindness**: *and* in your fear will I worship toward your holy temple.

Psa. 6:4 Return, O YAHWEH, deliver my soul: oh save me for your **kindnesses'** sake.

Psa. 13:5 But I have trusted in your **kindness**; my heart shall rejoice in your salvation.

Psa. 17:7 Show your marvellous **kindness**, O you that savest by your right hand them which put their trust *in you* from those that rise up *against them*.

Psa. 18:50 Great deliverance gives he to his king; and showeth **kindness** to his anointed, to David, and to his seed for evermore.

Psa. 136:23 Who remembered us in our low estate: for his **kindness endures** for ever:

Psa. 136:24 And has redeemed us from our enemies: for his **kindness endures** for ever.

Psa. 136:25 Who giveth food to all flesh: for his **kindness endures** for ever.

Psa. 136:26 O give thanks unto the Elohim of heaven: for his **kindness** *endures* for ever.

Dan. 1:9 Now The Elohim had brought Daniel into **kindness** and tender love with the prince of the eunuchs.

Dan. 9:4 And I prayed unto YAHWEH my Elohim, and made my confession, and said, O YAHWEH, the great and dreadful Elohim, keeping the covenant and **kindness** to them that love him, and to them that keep his commandments;

Hos. 2:19 And I will betroth you unto me for ever; yea, I will betroth you unto me in righteousness, and in judgment, and in **kindness**, and in mercies.

Psa. 89:19 Then you spakest in vision to your **kind one**, and saidst, I have laid help upon *one that is* mighty; I have exalted *one* chosen out of the people.

Psa. 97:10 You that love YAHWEH, hate evil: he preserves the beings of his **kind ones**; he delivers them out of the hand of the wicked.

Psa. 116:15 Precious in the sight of YAHWEH *is* the death of his **kind ones**.

Psa. 132:9 Let your priests be clothed with righteousness; and let your **kind ones** shout for joy.

Psa. 132:16 I will also clothe her priests with salvation: and her **kind ones** shall shout aloud for joy.

Psa. 145:10 All your works shall praise you, O YAHWEH; and your **kind ones** shall bless you.

Psa. 145:17 YAHWEH *is* righteous in all his ways, and **kind** in all his works.

Psa. 148:14 He also exalteth the horn of his people, the praise of all his **kind ones**; *even* of the children of Israel, a people near unto him. Praise ye YAHWEH.

Psa. 149:1 Praise ye YAHWEH. Sing unto YAHWEH a new song, *and* his praise in the congregation of **kind ones**.

Psa. 149:5 Let the **kind ones** be joyful in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds.

Psa. 149:9 To execute upon them the judgment written: this honour have all his **kind ones**. Praise YAHWEH!

Prov. 2:8 He keepeth the paths of judgment, and preserveth the way of his **kind ones**.

Jer. 3:12 Go and proclaim these words toward the north, and say, Return, you backsliding Israel, saith YAHWEH; *and* I will not cause mine anger to fall upon you: for I *am* **kind**, says YAHWEH, *and* I will not keep *anger* for ever.

1Cor. 15:19 If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most **in need of compassion**.

Rev. 3:17 Because you say I am rich and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and do not know that you art wretched, and **in need of compassion**, and poor, and blind, and naked:

1653 - to compassionate

Matt. 5:7 Blessed *are* the merciful: for they shall obtain **compassion**.

Matt. 9:27 And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed him, crying, and saying, *You* Son of David, have **compassion** on us.

Matt. 15:22 And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have **compassion** on me, O YAHWEH, *you* Son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil.

Matt. 17:15 YAHWEH, have **compassion** on my son: for he is lunatick, and sore vexed: for oftentimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water.

Matt. 18:33 Shouldest not you also have had **compassion** on your fellowservant, even as I had **compassion** on you?

Matt. 20:30 And, behold, two blind men sitting by the way side, when they heard that Jesus passed by, cried out, saying, Have **compassion** on us, O YAHWEH, *you* Son of David.

Matt. 20:31 And the multitude rebuked them, because they should hold their peace: but they cried the more, saying, Have **compassion** on us, O YAHWEH, *you* Son of David.

Mark 5:19 Howbeit Jesus suffered him not, but saith unto him, Go home to your friends, and tell them how great things YAHWEH has done for you, and has had **compassion** on you.

Mark 10:47 And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and say, Jesus, *you* Son of David, have **compassion** on me.

Mark 10:48 And many charged him that he should hold his peace: but he cried the more a great deal, *You* Son of David, have **compassion** on me.

Luke 16:24 And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have **compassion** on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.

Luke 17:13 And they lifted up *their* voices, and said, Jesus, Master, have **compassion** on us.

Luke 18:38 And he cried, saying, Jesus, *you* Son of David, have **compassion** on me.
Luke 18:39 And they which went before rebuked him, that he should hold his peace: but he cried so much the more, *You* Son of David, have **compassion** on me.

Rom. 9:15 For he saith to Moses, I will have **compassion** on whom I will have **compassion**, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion.
Rom. 9:16 So then *it is* not of him that wills, nor of him that runs, but of The Elohim who shows **compassion**.
Rom. 9:18 Therefore has He has **compassion** on whom he desires, and whom he deaires He hardens.

Rom. 11:30 For as you in times past have not believed The Elohim, yet have now obtained **compassion** through their unbelief:
Rom. 11:31 Even so have these also now not believed, that through your **compassion** they also may obtain **compassion**.
Rom. 11:32 For Elohim has concluded them all in unbelief, that he might have **compassion** upon all.

Rom. 12:8 Or he that exhorts, on exhortation: he that gives, *let him do it* with simplicity; he that rules, with diligence; he that shows **compassion**, with cheerfulness.

1Cor. 7:25 Now concerning virgins I have no commandment of YAHWEH: yet I give my judgment, as one that has obtained **compassion** of YAHWEH to be faithful.

2Cor. 4:1 Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received **compassion**, we faint not;

Phil. 2:27 For indeed he was sick near unto death: but The Elohim had **compassion** on him; and not on him only, but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow.

1Tim. 1:13 Who was before a blasphemer, and a persecutor, and injurious: but I obtained **compassion**, because I did *it* ignorantly in unbelief.

1Tim. 1:16 Howbeit for this cause I obtained **compassion**, that in me first YAHUSHUA, The Messiah, might show forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting.

1Pet. 2:10 Which in time past *were* not a people, but *are* now the people of The Elohim: which had not obtained **compassion**, but now have obtained **compassion**.

Jude 22 And of some have **compassion**, making a difference:

1654 - compassionateness

Matt. 6:1 Take heed that ye do not your **compassionateness** before men, to be seen of them: otherwise you have no reward of your Father who is in The Heaven.

Matt. 6:2 Therefore when you do **compassionateness**, do not sound a trumpet before you, as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may have honor from men. Truly I say unto you, They have their reward.

Matt. 6:3 But when you do **compassionateness**, let not your left hand know what your right hand does

Matt. 6:4 in order that your **compassionateness** may be in secret: and your Father who sees in secret himself shall reward you openly.

Luke 11:41 But rather give **compassionateness** of such things as you have; and, behold, all things are clean unto you.

Luke 12:33 Sell what you have, and give **compassionateness**; provide yourselves bags which wax not old, a treasure in the heavens that fails not, where no thief approaches, nor moth corrupts.

Acts 3:2 And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask **compassionateness** of them that entered into the temple;

Acts 3:3 Who seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple asked for **compassionateness**.

Acts 3:10 And they knew that it was he who sat for **compassionateness** at the Beautiful gate of the temple: and they were filled with wonder and amazement at that which had happened unto him.

Acts 9:36 Now there was at Joppa a certain disciple named Tabitha, which by interpretation is called Dorcas: this woman was full of good works and **compassionateness** which she did.

Acts 10:2 A devout *man*, and one that feared The Elohim with all his house, which gave much **compassionateness** to the people, and prayed to The Elohim always.

Acts 10:4 And when he looked on him, he was afraid, and said, What is it, YAHWEH? And he said unto him, Your prayers and thine **compassionateness** have come up as a memorial before The Elohim.

Acts 10:31 And said, Cornelius, your prayer is heard, and thine **compassionateness** are had in remembrance in the sight of The Elohim.

Acts 24:17 Now after many years I came to bring **compassionateness** to my nation, and offerings.

1655 - compassionate

Matt. 5:7 Blessed *are* the **compassionate**: for they shall obtain **compassion** (1653).

Heb. 2:17 Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto *his* brethren, that he might be a **compassionate** and faithful high priest in things *pertaining* to Elohim, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.

1656 - compassion

Matt. 9:13 But go ye and learn what *that* meaneth, I will have **compassion**, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

Matt. 12:7 But if ye had known what *this* meaneth, I will have **compassion**, and not sacrifice, ye would not have condemned the guiltless.

Matt. 23:23 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier *matters* of the law, judgment, **compassion**, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

Luke 1:50 And his **compassion** *is* on them that fear him from generation to generation.

Luke 1:54 He has holpen his servant Israel, in remembrance of *his* **compassion**;

Luke 1:58 And her neighbours and her cousins heard how YAHWEH had showed great **compassion** upon her; and they rejoiced with her.

Luke 1:72 To perform the **compassion** *promised* to our fathers, and to remember his holy covenant;

Luke 1:78 Through the tender **compassion** of our Elohim; whereby the dayspring from on high has visited us,

Luke 10:37 And he said, He that showed **compassion** on him. Then said Jesus unto him, Go, and do you likewise.

Rom. 9:23 And that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of **compassion**, which he had afore prepared unto glory,

Rom. 11:31 Even so have these also now not believed, that through your **compassion** they also may obtain mercy.

Rom. 15:9 And that the Gentiles might glorify Elohim for *his* **compassion**; as it is written, For this cause I will confess to you among the Gentiles, and sing unto your name.

Gal. 6:16 And as many as walk according to this rule, peace *be* on them, and **compassion**, and upon the Israel of Elohim.

Eph. 2:4 But Elohim, who is rich in **compassion**, for his great love wherewith he loved us,

Titus 3:5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his **compassion** he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

Heb. 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of favor, that we may obtain **compassion**, and find favor to help in time of need.

James 2:13 For he shall have judgment wiyout mercy, that has showed no **compassion**; and **mercy** rejoiceth against judgment.

James 3:17 But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of **compassion** and good fruits, wiyout partiality, and wiyout hypocrisy.

1Pet. 1:3 Blessed *be* the Elohim and Father of our YAHWEH Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant **compassion** has begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

2John 3 Favor be with you, **compassion**, and peace, from Elohim the Father, and from YAHWEH Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love.

Jude 2 **compassion** unto you, and peace, and love, be multiplied.

Jude 21 Keep yourselves in the love of Elohim, looking for the **compassion** of our YAHWEH Jesus Christ unto eternal life.

**2436 - cheerful, i.e. propitious; by Hebraism "YAHWEH be favorable!"
(compassionate)**

Matt. 16:22 Then Peter took him, and began to rebuke him, saying, **YAHWEH be favorable**, Master. This shall not be to you.

Heb. 8:12 For I will be **compassionate** to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.

3627 - have compassion on

Rom. 9:15 For he said to Moses, I will have **compassion (1653)** on whom I will have **compassion (1653)**, and I will have **compassion (3627)** on whom I will have **compassion (3627)**. {3627 leans more toward pity than compassion.}

3628 - have compassion on

Rom. 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the **compassions** of The Elohim, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto The Elohim, *which is* your reasonable service.

2Cor. 1:3 Blessed *be* The Elohim, even the Father of our sovereign, YAHUSHUA, The Messiah, the Father of **compassions**, and the Elohim of all comfort;

Phil. 2:1 If *there be* therefore any consolation in The Messiah, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the vital essence *of YAHWEH*, if any feelings (sympathies) and **compassions**,

Col. 3:12 Put on therefore, as the elect of The Elohim, holy and beloved, feelings (sympathies) of **compassions**, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;

Heb. 10:28 He that despised Moses' law died without **compassion** under two or three witnesses:

3629 - compassionate

Luke 6:36 Be you therefore **compassionate**, just as your Father also is **compassionate**.

James 5:11 Behold, we count them happy who endure. You have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the culmination (end goal) of YAHWEH; that YAHWEH is extremely sympathetic and **compassionate**.
